*When Fall comes around it brings with it memories of apples baking in the oven and the scent of something warm and spicy baking in the oven. To help you recreate those memories and make new ones of your own, we are sharing a recipe that we recently came across for **"APPLE SPICE JUMBO PIE CUPCAKES"**.*

Ingredients:

- 1 box refrigerated pie crusts, softened as directed on box
- 1 box spice cake mix with pudding
- water, vegetable oil and eggs as called for on cake mix box
- 1/2 cup apple pie filling (from 21 oz can)
- 1 container cream cheese creamy ready-to-spread frosting



Directions:

Heat oven to 450°F. Remove pie crusts from pouches; unroll on work surface. Cut six 4 3/4-inch rounds from each crust. Firmly press 1 round in bottom and up the sides of each of 12 nonstick jumbo muffin cups. Bake 5 minutes.

Reduce oven temperature to 350°F. Make cake batter as directed on box. Divide apple pie filling evenly among pastry-lined muffin cups. Top with cake batter, dividing evenly among muffin cups.

Bake 30 to 33 minutes or until toothpick inserted in the center of cake comes out clean. Cool completely. Frost with frosting.

The next step is the best step...pour yourself an ice cold glass of milk or a hot cup of coffee, have a seat and enjoy the fruits of your labor!

A WORD ABOUT THE LAUNDRY ROOMS

- 1) Do not overload the washing machines, as these are not commercial machines and overloading causes mechanical problems as well as the belts to break.
- 2) Time your wash and dry loads so that you can remove your laundry in a reasonable time leaving the machines available for your neighbor.
- 3) Do not dye clothing in the machines.
- 4) Wipe out the washer and empty the lint tray of the dryer when you are finished.
- 5) Always, remember to close the laundry room door when you are done with your laundry.

Remember, the laundry room in each building is there for **ALL** the residents in the building. If everyone follows these 5 simple steps when using the laundry room it will make laundry day a little less stressful for everyone.
